Mr. McNab and Mr. Konkel:

Larimer County appreciates that WOLF has complied with the Commissioners' directive by removing the 4 WOLF animals from the site. There remains an additional matter to be resolved by WOLF. Code Enforcement Officer Chad Gray inspected the property recently to confirm that the 4 animals had been removed and that the fences/pens built OUTSIDE the 5-acre area approved for operation of the Facility (during the 1st special review) had been removed. These fences/pens have NOT been removed. The fences constructed WITHIN the 5-acre may remain but still need to have building permits. The County is requesting that these matters be corrected on or before March 20. Mr. Gray will conduct an inspection at that time to determine compliance. As you are aware, failure to comply with the terms of the special review (e.g., expanding the Facility by creating new structures outside the approved area) is grounds for the Commissioners to hold a show cause hearing to consider revocation of the special review permit. The County may also apply for an injunction to allow the County to remove the fences/pens and charge the costs of removal as a lien against the property collectible in the same manner and with the same priority as a tax lien. The County hopes that it will not need to resort to these measures to achieve compliance of these two simple issues.
